2.3 Lighting and Reflectors

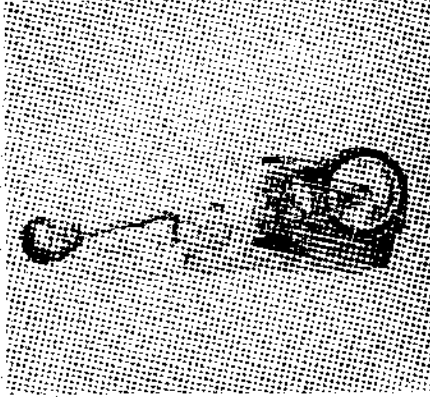
Almost all jurisdictions require use of pedal, wheel, front, and rear reflectors. An adequate electric headlamp is usually required for riding after dark.

An electric taillamp, even if not required, is recommended for your safety and visibility. The use of light colored or reflective clothing is also strongly advised. Clip-on, battery-operated lamps can be purchased from your local dealer.

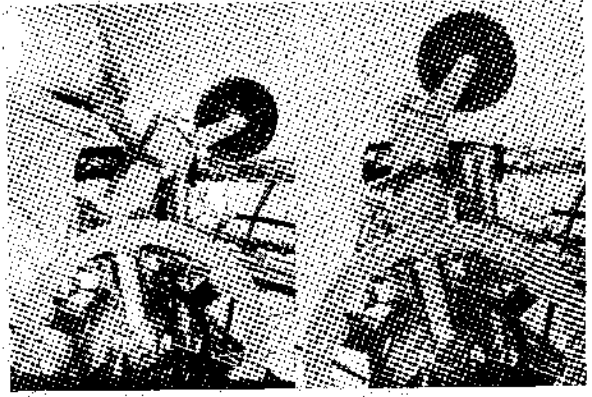
3. HOW TO OPERATE DAHON FOLDER

Attention Owners: The following instructions explain what we feel is the fastest and most efficient way to fold and unfold DAHON Folder while standing on the left side of the bike. Naturally, the steps can be done in many different orders, and from either the left or right side. Feel free to change the order of certain steps to better suit your preference.

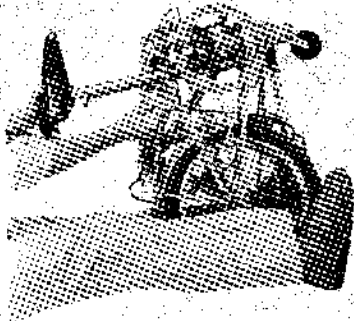
3.1 Unfolding



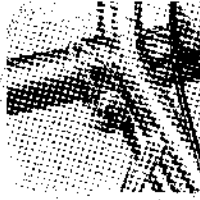
1. Begin with bike folded in upright position.



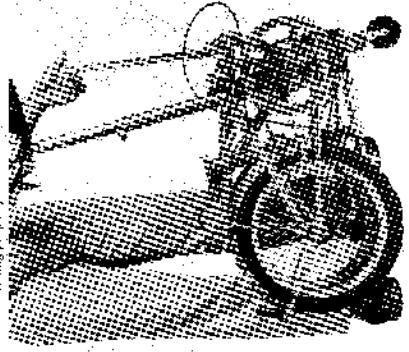
2. Flip out on metal actuator to lower rear wheel.



3. Resting the bicycle on wheels and castor wheel, adjust seat post by releasing clamps and pulling upwards on saddle. Always adjust lower seat post first to highest position, being careful not to exceed the "Safety Mark."



4. Warning: Before riding, always double check seat post clamps to insure they are closed and working properly!



5. Swing handlebar brace to upright position.
